

Summer Blast is a 5 day over-night camp for kids who will enter grades 3rd-6th this fall (campers must be at least 8 years old by July 1, 2023). The program is cooperatively organized and run by various protestant churches. Our all-volunteer staff is made up of Christian adults who have been individually qualified through an application process and background check. Each is committed to make this camp experience safe and meaningful for each and every camper. It is our desire to share with them the reality of our faith in the context of a camping program designed with them specifically in mind. Our location is CAMP WOOTEN, an Environmental Learning Center established by Washington State's Parks and Recreation Commission for the purpose of providing youth with a place to enjoy nature and to study the environment. Located next to the Tucannon River in the beautiful surroundings of the Blue Mountains, Camp Wooten has safe hiking trails, an indoor swimming pool, tennis, volleyball and basketball courts, ball fields, and a small lake.
